WHO CAN USE NETLIBRARY?

Members of the Montclair State University community have access to netLibrary.

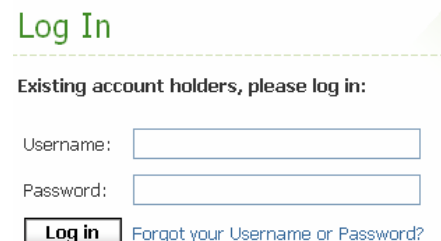
THERE ARE TWO WAYS OF ACCESSING eBooks at netLibrary:

- **Link directly to netLibrary to search the collection** – the netLibrary URL is: www.netlibrary.com.

By typing in this web address, you are directed to a login screen. If you have already established a free account with netLibrary, just type in your username and password. Once verified, you can then search, preview and checkout titles to which the Sprague Library has access.



If you are brand-new to netLibrary, you will need to “create an account,” which is your personal borrowing account for netLibrary. In order to create an account, please follow the instructions on the screen. New users **MUST** use a computer within the Sprague Library or connect to netLibrary via the method below to create an account. Once an account is created, users can access netLibrary from any computer.



- **Link from the Library catalog to a specific title in netLibrary.** When searching the catalog for books, if your desired title specifies that it is an **electronic resource** and the library holdings indicate that the title is located **online**, it is an eBook.

Click the url link to access the netLibrary title.

On campus the url link will give immediate access to the title at netLibrary.

Off campus the url link will take you to a login screen that asks for your MSU email account username and password before giving access to the title at netLibrary.

- When the title has been accessed, the eBook Summary page is displayed. Then, select the ***View this eBook*** link, and the text will be displayed. If you have questions about using an eBook, the ***Help*** tab on the top of the screen offers helpful information.
