**JSTOR**

Archive of full-text journal articles in African American studies, African studies, anthropology, archeology, Asian studies, Classical studies, ecology, economics, education, finance, geography, history, *language and literature*, Latin American studies, philosophy, political science, population studies, Slavic studies, sociology, and statistics.

**MLA (Modern Language Association) Bibliography**

Index to articles and other material on modern languages, literature, linguistics and folklore. Covers subjects from prose to poetry, genres to literary forms, national literatures and regional dialects.

**INFOTRAC**

Index to articles on a variety of subjects. Full text of many articles available.

**LLBA (Linguistics and Language)**

Index to articles, books, and dissertations in linguistics, speech, language, and hearing pathology, and language research.
